

Four Guiding Principles during the COVID-19 Pandemic:

1. Maintain a healthy and safe environment for all students, families, and staff.
 2. Provide the services needed to support the children of our essential workers.
 3. Support vulnerable students who may need special assistance.
 4. Provide continuity of educational opportunities for all students.
 5. Promote positive relationships and keep students at the centre of our learning.
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1. Learning Groups & Timetable

- LVR will be running a “one in five” schedule, where students take one course with one teacher every five and a half weeks.
- Students will remain in their learning group for the term with the maximum group size being 120, including adults. Where possible, the learning groups will be limited to under 90.
- Learning groups are comprised of smaller cohorts consisting of 25 – 30 students and 1 – 3 staff members. Students will be informed by of their learning group prior to their orientation days on September 10th or 11th.

2. Bell Schedule & Breaks

- School bell schedule
 - Morning bell: 8:40am
 - End of day bell: 3:17pm
- Break and lunch times will be staggered for each learning group.
- Scheduled breaks will be supervised.
- Each learning group will have a section of the school and outdoor space to have their breaks.
- Students will eat lunch in their homeroom.
- LVR is a closed campus to ensure the continued safety of our staff, students, and community, and to maintain the integrity of the learning groups.

3. Movement Through the Building

- Students will enter through their marked learning group door. Each learning group will be assigned a letter of the alphabet and will use the corresponding door. Class teachers will meet students at the door for entry, and walk students to the door for dismissal. Students will receive information from their teacher prior to school startup.
- Upon entering the building, students sanitize hands and proceed directly to their classroom with their teacher. On entering their classroom, they are to sanitize (if not done at the entry door).
- Students will be walking on the right through the halls and stairwells. All students will need a hall pass to leave their classroom and use washrooms.
- Break and lunch times will be in designated areas with adult supervision.

4. Health and Safety

- All visitors (including all parents) must make an appointment with the Principal / Vice Principals and sign in/ out with the secretary. They must wear a mask and complete the health & safety check.
- Hand washing and sanitization stations protocols will be followed. Upon entry to LVR, visitors and staff will use the front entrance washroom or sanitization station to wash hands before proceeding to sign in.
- Staff and students are required to wear non-medical mask when in high traffic areas such as busses, hallways, and outside of their learning groups.
- Staff and students may choose to wear masks at any other time if that is their personal preference.
- Two non-medical face masks will be made available to staff and students upon arrival.
- If a child feels sick during the day, during the day, the family will be contacted and student will be isolated in a separate room. The regular first aid room will be used for emergencies only.

5. Transportation

- Bus protocols will follow the school District guidelines. These guidelines will be communicated to families.
- Bus loading and unloading – socially distanced, with masks
- Parents/guardians who arrive to pick up their students must wait inside the vehicle
