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1. Learning Groups & Timetable

2. Bell Schedule & Breaks

- School bell schedule
- Schedule for staggered breaks and lunches
- There will be 4-6 outside learning zones and students will be rotated through
- Students will eat lunch in their classroom
- Closed campus
- Grade 8's will eat lunch during the regularly scheduled lunch
- Grade 6 and 7 English program will eat lunch during period four
- Grade 6 and 7 French Immersion will eat lunch during period three

3. Movement Through the Building

- Grade 6's south main entrance off of Josephine St.
- Grade 8's central main entrance off of Josephine St.
- Grade 7's north main entrance off of Josephine St.
- Parents, contractors lower Hall St.
- Staff upper Hall St. catwalk
- Students will go directly to their classroom using assigned stairs and hallways
- Each grade is assigned their own set of washrooms

4. Health and Safety

- All visitors (including parents) must make an appointment with the Principal and sign in/out with the secretary. They must wear a mask and complete the health & safety check.
- Hand washing and sanitization stations used upon entry and exit of the building and will be frequently used during the school day.
- Masks/PPE: 2 masks for each child

- If your child is sick you are to keep them home. Children that get sick at school will be accompanied to the medical room with their backpack and parents will be asked to pick them up.
- Non-medical masks are required to be used in situations where a person cannot maintain physical distance and is in close proximity to a person outside their learning group. Our school will have non-medical masks available for staff and students. Masks are not required for younger elementary; however we strongly encourage everyone to wear one.

5. Transportation

- Students will socially distance both entering and leaving the bus.
- Middle and secondary students are required to wear a mask on the school bus. Exceptions will be made for students who cannot wear masks for medical reasons.
