

#### Nelson Family of Schools - All Schools Avg. FCI, Utilization & Deferred Maintenance






## Nelson Family of Schools FCI, Utilization & Deferred Maintenance



#### Trafalgar Middle School

- Built: 1924
- Operating Capacity: 575
- Total Student Enrolment = 413
  - Elementary = 280
  - Secondary = 133
- **Building Metrics:** 
  - Capacity Utilization: 72%
  - Facilities Condition Index: 0.54
  - Deferred Maintenance: \$9.56 MM





## School District No. 8 Historic Births within District






The number of births to women residing within the Kootenay Lake School District has decreased significantly over the last 8 years, with 2017 reaching the lowest number in over 20 years. The children currently enrolled in grades K-12 were born between 2001 and 2013, during which time the number of births per year averaged 368. Over the last 4 years, the births have averaged 315 per year, a decrease of 53.




- Operating Capacity in Nelson Family of Schools
  - o 109 = Blewett Elementary School
  - 200 = Central Elementary School
  - 245 = Hume Elementary School
  - 725 = L.V. Rogers Secondary School
  - 132 = Redfish Elementary School
  - o 154 = Rosemont Elementary School
  - 199 = South Nelson Elementary School
  - 575 = Trafalgar Middle School
  - 2,339 = Total Operating Capacity
- 90% Capacity Utilization in Nelson Family of Schools (= 2,164 Students / 2,339 Op. Capacity).
- 96% Capacity Utilization in 2023 (=2,253 Students / 2,339 Op. Capacity)
- This compares with 76% average Capacity Utilization in SD8.

#### L.V. Rogers Secondary School Enrolment Projection (2016-2033) Status Quo (Grades 9-12)




Total Enrolment Patterns 2016 - 2033 L.V. Rogers Secondary

#### Nelson Family of Schools LV Rogers Reconfig. Proposal #1 - Considerations



#### LV Rogers

- Expansion of capacity not feasible.
- Removing non-core student groups (DESK, Out-of-Catchment Students, CSF courses, International students, Kootenay Kids) does not solve over-capacity issue and is undesirable and/or out of line with our core values.
- Alternate scheduling proposals (Out-of-timetable or AM/PM) do not solve problem are are undesirable if there is better alternative.
- Benefits of LV Rogers Grades 10-12:
  - Focus on new curriculum grad program Grades 10-12.
  - Addresses existing capacity utilization issues (e.g. gym, science labs, etc.).
  - Space for diverse programming, potential new academies.
- Still have capacity utilization over 80% in 2020, 94% in 2024 (but actually full when factoring in DESK's utilization).

## Nelson Family of Schools - Trafalgar & Elementary Reconfig. Proposal #1 - Considerations



#### Trafalgar Middle

- Ample capacity for Grades 6-9.
- Aligned to new Elementary K-9 curriculum.
  - Adapted course programming best suited to each grade and program.
- Renovations/upgrade/modernization also being considered in tandem under proposed new Facilities Plan.

#### Nelson Elementary Schools

- Where elementary schools have capacity, parent/student choice for Grade 6 to either continue at their school, or move on to Trafalgar:
  - Redfish already configured to keep Grade 6s
  - Rosemont, Hume and South Nelson can keep Grade 6s, depending on numbers.
  - Blewett cannot keep Grades 6s until/if expansion project complete.
