5-Year Capital Ops Plan



Summary of Expenditures Year-to-Date

- TOTAL 5-Year Capital Plan = \$20,278,470
 - All funding sources (MoE, Board, Grants & Donations)
 - 2020-2021 Approved Spending = \$5,066,914*
 - 2020-2021 May 5, 2021 Year-to-Date = \$4,846,369
 - 2020-2021 Budget remaining = \$220,545 = 4%

Breakdown of Expenditures YTD by Funding Source

- 5-Year MoE Programs = \$15,463,470
 - AFG, SEP, PEP, CNCP, BUS
 - 2020-2021 Approved Spending = \$3,567,338*
 - 2020-2021 May 5, 2021 Year-to-Date Spent = \$2,954,376
 - 2020-2021 Budget remaining = \$612,692 = 17%
- 5-Year SD8 Board Additional Commitment = \$4,775,000
 - Operating, Local Capital, Property Disposals & Leases
 - 2020-2021 Approved Spending = \$1,206,742*
 - 2020-2021 May 5, 2021 Year-to-Date Spent = \$1,600,928
 - 2020-2021 Budget remaining = \$(394,186) = (33%) overspend
- 5-Year Other Funding = \$40,000
 - Grants & Donations
 - 2020-2021 Approved Spending = \$292,834*
 - 2020-2021 May 5, 2021 Year-to-Date Spent = \$291,065

Local Capital - Property Sales

- Majority of Funding Comes from MoE Annual Programs, some Operating Funding plus existing Local Capital Fund contribution.
- Contribution from property disposals = \$1,000,000 over five years.
 - 2020-2021 5-Year Capital Plan estimate = \$200,000
 - 2020-2021 Actual disposal proceeds = \$1,089,172
 (\$272,293 unrestricted + \$816,879 restricted)
- SD8 properties currently listed for sale:
 - Retallack \$88,000 (=\$49,000+\$39,000)
 - Yahk \$275,000 (\$225,000 + \$50,000)
 - Ymir \$10,000
 - TOTAL current listings = \$373,000




