 - Parents and teachers

What are digital literacy skills?

- ▶ 1. Define effective research questions
- ▶ 2. Access online sources of information
- ➤ 3. Assess the credibility of sources
- ▶ 4. Effectively utilize credible sources of information
- ▶ 5. Appropriately reference sources

Why is this an issue?

- ▶ 1. Need to empower our youth
- ▶ 2. Need to help rural communities retain their youth

How can we address this critical need?

- Pilot and evaluate an approach at LVR to define a longer-term strategy for SD8
- ► Fall 2014
 - ► Specific course for grades 10-12
 - Evaluate to learn
- ▶ Spring 2013
 - ► Work with grade 9s
 - Evaluate to learn
- ▶ Fall 2015
 - ▶ Broader implementation

What do we need?

- ▶ LVR Requests support for release time for teacher planning, collaborating, implementation, and evaluation of program
- Approximately 14-16 1.0 FTE days (\$4900-5200)
- Evaluation and feedback from District on long term feasibility and adaptability of program for district-wide implementation
