Goal of Project (*what will the project accomplish?*):

Replace old, tired and worn out equipment within the Technology Education shops throughout SD8 which will benefit students in the following:
Improved safety for students and staff using equipment
Introduce students to experiencing trades as a career option
Provide students the opportunity to work with modern equipment/technology
Bring equipment in all shops up to modern standards
Standardizing equipment in shops makes maintenance more time and cost efficient
Financial savings in bulk purchasing the same manufacturer/model of equipment
