They also include platforms that build and online digital community. SIS (Student Information System) platforms can also be included in this category.</p> <p><i>Eg./ MyEducation BC, Moodle, SD8Learns (Campus Press)</i></p>	<p>Grading and Reporting Platforms can be stand alone or embedded within another LMS, SMS, or SIS. They also include IT infrastructure and operations software.</p> <p><i>Eg./ Microsoft Windows 10, Faronics Insight, Meraki</i></p>	<p>Administrative applications include those that support school functions over and above district infrastructure licenses. They may include voice message protocols, data management, fees and appointments, and mail list distribution management software.</p> <p><i>Eg./ L4U, Synrevoice, Appointments Online, Edulogs</i></p>

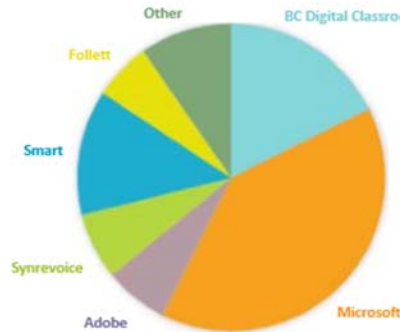
