This award is offered to a graduating L.V. Rogers or Mount Sentinel student. The student **must be** a child of a City of Nelson Employee in a permanent position with greater than 5 years of service. If no applicants with criteria apply, this award is to be offered to any student who demonstrates a balance of academics, athletics, leadership and is community oriented.

Applicants must be Canadian citizens, permanent residents (landed immigrants) residing in SD8 Kootenay Lake, and must fulfill the BC Graduation requirements by August 31st of the student's graduating year.
