

Dr. Amanda Asay Memorial Award

The Dr. Amanda Asay Memorial Award is in honour of the Prince George legend who tragically lost her life in a skiing accident in Nelson, BC. The purpose of the fund is to create a legacy in the name of Amanda Asay with the creation of this annual award. Born and raised in Prince George, Asay was the longest-serving member of the he Women's National Team program having joined the squad in 2005 and recently participated in the Women's National Team Showcase last summer in Trois-Rivières, Que. She was part of national teams that captured five WBSC Women's Baseball World Cup medals including bronze in 2006, 2012 and 2018 and silver in 2008 and 2016. She was also part of Canada's historic silver medal performance at the 2015 Pan Am Games in Toronto - the first time that women's baseball was included in a major, multi-sport games.

Criteria

The Dr. Amanda Asay Memorial Award is one bursary to be allocated to a student attending post secondary school from School District No. 8 (Kootenay Lake). Preference will be given to female students, going to post-secondary education, who participates in hockey, ringette, baseball or softball.

Applicants must be Canadian citizens, permanent residents (landed immigrants) residing in SD8 Kootenay Lake, and must fulfill the BC Graduation requirements by August 31st of the student's graduating year.
