Academic Requirements

- English 10 with a 60% or higher
- Internationally educated students whose first language is not English will need to supply evidence of language proficiency as per the HCA registry requirements

Non-Academic Requirements

- Three (3) references
- Applicant questionnaire
- English language declaration form
- Computer skills form
- Signed Participation agreement. The purpose of this Participation Agreement is to ensure students are fully informed about the nature of the Off-Campus Activities, and the College's expectations of students who attend these excursions. It is also important students understand the physical demands, risks or hazards that may arise from participation in these Activities.

All students who participate will be required to sign and return a copy of this Participation Agreement. Students who do not sign this Participation Agreement will not be permitted to register in courses.

Practicum Requirements (after acceptance to program, prior to practicum classes)

- Ministry of Justice Criminal Record Check (RCMP checks not accepted and will be returned)
- FoodSafe: Community Education
- Standard First Aid with CPR C or Emergency First Aid with CPR C: Community Education
- Immunization form, including immunity to Tuberculosis
 - For applicable practicum sites, applicants must be able to demonstrate compliance with Public Health Officer's orders with respect to COVID-19 vaccine requirements.
