Definition:

Near Miss: a potential hazard or incident that had the potential but did not result in any personal injury or property damage. Unsafe working conditions, unsafe employee work habits, improper use of equipment or use of malfunctioning equipment that may have had the potential to cause work-related injuries or property damage.
