

# 11.5 Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect

# WHAT TO DO IF YOU THINK A CHILD IS BEING ABUSED OR NEGLECTED...

If you think a child or youth under the age of 19 is being abused or neglected, you have the legal duty to report your concern to your local child welfare worker at a Ministry of Children and Family Development.

# Call 1-800-663-9122. This line is available 24 hours a day.

You can also call the Helpline for Children at **310-1234** at any time of the day or night. The Helpline call is free. You do not need an area code and you do not have to give your name.

## If the child is in immediate danger, call 9-1-1
