

Requirements

- You must be registered as a student in either School District 5, 6, 8, or at Kootenay Christian Academy.
- An approved graduation plan developed with a school counsellor prior to graduation, including a defined career pathway that includes the foundation or apprenticeship program.
- You must begin the program before turning 19 and complete the program before turning 20.
- Complete the tasks outlined in this package, including all the required signatures from your school counsellor(s), parent(s) or guardian(s), and yourself.
- Complete and submit the College of the Rockies forms.

It's also strongly recommended that you:

- 1. Try to enhance your skills through volunteer or paid work experience in your preferred trade.
- 2. Work on developing the essential skills you need to succeed in the trade. Signing up for skillplan.ca is a good start to help you prepare. https://skillplan.ca/learn/
- Contact College Recruitment Officers at <u>recruit@cotr.bc.ca</u> to arrange to participate in the Student for a Day program to meet instructors and get a better sense of the program.



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This is an agreement between you (the student) and the College of the Rockies (Technical Training Institute) and School Districts #5, #6, #8, and Kootenay Christian Academy.
