

6.4 Seizure Care

ADMINISTRATION OF SEIZURE RESCUE MEDICATIONS

The Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education and Child Care have developed <u>Seizure Rescue Intervention Resources</u> for student seizure care at school. To support students requiring emergency seizure rescue intervention in the school setting, and to support schools and staff in providing emergency seizure rescue care in a timely manner, the following documents have been updated for the 2024/2025 school year:

- Seizure Action Plan (SAP) form
- o Request for Seizure Rescue Intervention Training form
- School checklist for Seizure Care Planning

Schools should ensure to use the updated documents when developing a student's SAP and when requesting seizure rescue intervention training.

All the updated resources and new fillable forms can be found on the <u>Nursing Support</u> <u>Services (NSS) Resources web page</u> under the "Learn about seizure care in the school setting" tab.

For students with seizures, parents — with their physician — need to complete a <u>Seizure Action Plan</u> yearly so that school staff can effectively care for students.
