



Dr. Christine Perkins Human Rights Award

The Dr. Christine Perkins Human Rights Award is available to local-area (West Kootenay) Indigenous or Inclusion students residing in the catchment of SD8 pursuing degrees in education, law or human rights at a post-secondary, degree-granting institution.

Criteria

Eligible students must demonstrate a combination of an interest in pursuing a career in education, law or human rights and have academic potential, and financial need. Applicants must demonstrate enthusiasm, innovation and excellence through their portfolio and application materials. The applicant must be a resident of SD 8. Where possible, awards will be distributed over different disciplines in consecutive years.

It is important to review and meet criteria of each application to ensure consideration.

Applicants must be Canadian citizens, permanent residents (landed immigrants) residing in SD8 Kootenay Lake, and must fulfill the BC Graduation requirements by August 31st of the student's graduating year.
