

Get High on Nature Scholarship

The Get High on Nature Scholarship is available to students graduating from Salmo Secondary School, Mount Sentinel Secondary School or L.V. Rogers Secondary School pursuing post-secondary education in an area related to environmental studies and must have solid evidence of environmental activities.

Eligible students must provide a reference from their school, a one page statement as to why you are interested in pursuing environmental studies, and a list of previous involvement in environmental activities. The applicant must be a resident of SD 8.

Applicants must be Canadian citizens, permanent residents (landed immigrants) residing in SD8 Kootenay Lake, and must fulfill the BC Graduation requirements by August 31st of the student's graduating year.
